Conservation, Management, & Utilization

Tanzania's wildlife conservation depends on hunting to a great extent for its long-term survival. Tourist hunting provides revenue to the Wildlife Division for conservation and anti poaching in remote areas that would otherwise be unsupported. (Most hunting areas are unsuitable to photo-tourism).



Anti-Poaching

Revenue from hunting directly supports the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism to manage wildlife and its habitat. Hunting gives value to the wildlife and the land they inhabit. This value transforms into habitat preservation and acts as a deterrent against poaching
